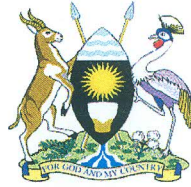

**PAYMENT OF DOMESTIC ARREARS IN THE SECOND QUARTER (OCTOBER TO DECEMBER) FY 2018/19.**

Reference is made to our letter of even reference dated 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2018 in which the Expenditure Limits for GoU Wage, Non-Wage Recurrent and Development as well as Appropriation in Aid and External Financing for the period October to December 2018 for Financial Year 2018/19 were communicated to you.

I wish to draw your attention to the expenditure limits for arrears under different categories in the referenced letter. All arrears balances as budgeted for in FY 2018/19 were released for payment in the Second Quarter.

The purpose of this letter, therefore, is to advise you to pay Domestic Arrears that have been audit verified and without any contention. Relatedly as stated in the referenced letter communicating the Second Quarter expenditure limits, Para.3, I wish to re-emphasize that payment for Salary, Pension and Gratuity Arrears should also be made to the verified persons and for the verified amounts.
